
### **AMUR MAPLE** Acer ginnala



Spreading, irregular shrub. Showy red winged samaras in summer. Extremely hardy and very adaptable. Beautiful red fall colour.

#### AMUR MAPLE- EMERALD ELF Acer ginnala 'Emerald Elf'

A compact, rounded plant suitable for a variety of uses, including hedging and foundation plants. Provides an important role in the fall landscape with its stunning red fall colour.





#### AMUR MAPLE- FLAME Acer ginnala 'Flame'

#### BLUE ICE BOG ROSEMARY Andromeda polifolia 'Blue Ice'



Sought after compact form delivers striking three season interest. Smooth, glossy dark green foliage turns a brilliant shade of red in fall. White spring flowers transform into dark edible fruits for late season enjoyment.


### LOW SCAPE MOUND™ CHOKEBERRY Aronia melanocarpa 'UCONNAM165'

Spring, summer, fall

Low-growing, tough, tolerant and tidy groundcover shrub, providing beauty from spring to frost. White flowers in spring followed by brilliant red leaves in fall with purple fruit.





# VIKING CHOKEBERRY Aronia melanocarpa 'Viking'



1.5 m / 5' ↔ 1 m / 3' COPF

Upright shrub. Produces shiny black berries in late summer which are good for jelly and will last into winter for birds. Red fall colour.

#### EMERALD CAROUSEL® BARBERRY Berberis 'Tara'

A cross between Japanese and Korean Barberry, giving this selection some added hardiness. Rounded shrub with arching, thorny branches and showy yellow flowers. Red to reddish-purple fall foliage and glossy, red berries.







# DWARF GOLDEN BARBERRY Berberis thunbergii 'Aurea Nana'

A classic favorite for landscape focal points. Best used in groups and shrub borders.

## RUBY CAROUSEL® BARBERRY Berberis thunbergii 'Bailone'

Upright, arching growth habit lends this plant for specimen appeal. Bright red foliage throughout the growing season lasts well into the fall. Performs best in well drained soil with full sun location.



# CONCORDE BARBERRY Berberis thunbergii 'Concorde'

A dwarf, rounded plant producing deep purple foliage. Small yellow flowers and red berries. Excellent for low hedge.



#### ROYAL BURGUNDY® BARBERRY Berberis thunbergii 'Gentry'

Rich burgundy foliage holds colour well, even through summer, turning darker in fall. Compact, mounded form lends itself to a variety of landscape uses.



#### CHERRY BOMB® BARBERRY Berberis thunbergii 'Monomb'

Compact, rounded form make a wonderful low hedge, barrier planting or single shrub accent. Crimson foliage and bright red berries enhance its look in fall and winter.



#### SUNSATION® BARBERRY Berberis thunbergii 'Monry'





A compact, rounded habit. Displays attractive yellow foliage. Provides an excellent color contrast with green-leaved plants.



#### ROSE GLOW BARBERRY Berberis thunbergii 'Rose Glow'

A popular choice with gardeners. New foliage emerges as rose-pink in colour with deeper mottled splotches of reddish-purple that generally mature to a maroon. This selection has a compact rounded form.

New growth appears in sunset hues of yellow, red, and orange. Cheerful chartreuse foliage carries the plant through the entire season.

#### CALGARY BOXWOOD Buxus 'Calgary'

Dense, slow growing evergreen shrub that responds well to shearing for desired form and shape. Plant in sheltered area away from drying winds for best results.





# **COMMON CARAGANA** Caragana arborescens

Upright form, excellent for hedges or shelterbelts. Long narrow seed pods appear after flowers. Requires good drainage. A suitable choice for use in windbreaks.

#### GLOBE CARAGANA Caragana frutex 'Globosa'



A low maintenance compact, globe-shaped shrub. Makes a suitable replacement for globe cedars. Intense, new fresh green foliage adds to spring landscape.





#### PYGMY CARAGANA Caragana pygmaea



An arching, spreading and thorny shrub. Prefers hot, dry locations and is salt tolerant making it an excellent landscape shrub. Small bright yellow flowers emerge from year old wood.

#### IVORY HALO® DOGWOOD Cornus alba 'Bailhalo'

A rounded shrub with yellow stems. Appears resistant to die back or canker. Extreme hardiness makes it an excellent choice for chinook regions.

# CREAM CRACKER DOGWOOD Cornus alba 'Cream Cracker'

Dwarf, rounded shrub. Leaves are green with creamy-coloured margins on the older growth. New growth is green with golden-yellow margins. A recent award winner, Cream Cracker is more compact than Ivory Halo®.





#### LITTLE REBEL® DOGWOOD Cornus alba 'Jefreb'

This attractive groundcover is suited to shade with its light green veined foliage and blooms that produce small bright red berries. Red fall foliage.



#### **GREY DOGWOOD** Cornus racemosa

# **RED OSIER DOGWOOD** Cornus sericea

# FIREDANCE™ DOGWOOD Cornus sericea 'Bailadeline'

This compact variety has green foliage in the spring and summer. In the fall it turns red-purple, and when the leaves drop it's red stems add winter interest. It is also tolerant to moist conditions and slopes.

A compact, spreading form and dense growth habit. Heavy producer of white fruit in late summer through fall. The fruits persist adding interest to the winter landscape.





# PUCKER UP!® DOGWOOD Cornus sericea 'Neil Z'





A unique Dogwood featuring distinctive thick, puckered, glossy green foliage that are deer resistant. This attractive plant lends itself to a variety of landscape uses including mass plantings, borders or an accent feature. Bright red winter stems adds value to the winter landscape.

Highly desired size and form allows this plant to fit into a number of landscapes. Red stems are a popular choice for winter bouquets. A Red Osier selection that does not produce the suckering like the species.

# **AMERICAN HAZELNUT** Corylus americana

Upright, spreading form with heart-shaped dark foliage. Edible nuts, 1.5 cm (0.5") in length are produced and can be used for baking. Suitable for back of the border planting or for naturalizing.





# **BEAKED HAZELNUT** Corylus cornuta

Upright, spreading shrub with coarse green-toothed foliage and catkins in spring followed by edible 1.5 cm (0.5") nuts. Useful for naturalizing and wildlife planting.

### WINECRAFT BLACK® SMOKEBUSH Cotinus coggygria 'NCCO1'





In spring, round leaves emerge rich purple, summer deep near black tone and fall an array of reds and oranges.





### ROYAL PURPLE SMOKEBUSH Cotinus coggygria 'Royal Purple'

This shrub or small tree has stunning dark red-purple foliage that turns scarlet in autumn. It has plume-like seed clusters, which appear after the flowers and give a long-lasting, smoky haze to branch tips.

#### **HEDGE COTONEASTER** Cotoneaster lucidus

Upright shrub makes an excellent hedge and produces bluish-black berries in summer. Good red fall colour.

Leaves are a dark reddish-purple making the vibrant yellow flowers from spring to summer stand out.

# RUSSIAN OLIVE Elaeagnus angustifolia





This rounded shrub or small tree makes an excellent contrast in colour for landscaping with its grey foliage. Very tolerant to salt, drought, and poor soils.







# **WOLF WILLOW** Elaeagnus commutata



Also known as Silverberry. Upright, spreading shrub with silver-grey foliage. Small, egg-shaped, silvery fruit is produced in summer.

# **DWARF WINGED BURNING BUSH** Euonymus alatus 'Compactus'



1 m / 3' ↔ 1 m / 3' 🛞 May-June

Very compact, rounded shrub with unique corky winged ridges on bark. Fall colour changes early and lasts late in the season. Orange-red fruit-like capsules add to this outstanding colour.



# CHICAGO FIRE™ BURNING BUSH Euonymus alatus 'Timber Creek'

Rounded shrub. The brilliant fire-red fall foliage colour appears earlier than does 'Compacta'. Attractive orange fruit. The best fall color.



#### TURKESTAN DWARF BURNING BUSH Euonymus nanus 'Turkestanicus'

This compact, spreading, semi-evergreen shrub is an excellent addition to any landscape as a low hedge or border.



# **SEA BUCKTHORN** Hippophae rhamnoides

This upright shrub retains its yellow/orange fruit through winter but is not eaten by birds. Has thorny twigs with willow-like leaves with a silvery-green underside.



#### LEIKORA SEABERRY Hippophae rhamnoides 'Leikora'



1.5-3 m / 5-10' ↔ 1.5-3 m / 5-10' March-April



Leikora is a female Seaberry with an irregular growth habit. Its flowers are inconspicuous greenish-brown in March and April, followed by juicy, yellow-orange fruits that have a very high vitamin C concentration. Great fruit yield. Needs a male pollinator.





1 4 m / 13' ↔ 3 m / 10' April



Upright shrub mainly used in mass planting. Selected male useful as a pollinator. One Pollmix can pollinate up to 5 female plants. Can also be shaped into a tree.





INCREDIBALL® HYDRANGEA Hydrangea arborescens 'Abetwo'

An improved Annabelle characterized by its mounded habit. Produces huge, white flowers on extremely strong stems. Excellent display all summer long right up until frost.

ANNABELLE HYDRANGEA Hydrangea arborescens 'Annabelle'

1 m / 3' ↔ 1 m / 3' ﴿ July-September

Excellent rounded shrub with its favorite long lasting round flower clusters. Prefers moist soil in sheltered location.
