



**ADELAIDE HOODLESS ROSE** *Rosa 'Adelaide Hoodless'*

  1 m / 3'  1 m / 3'  July-September corf

Large clusters of semi-double, bright red blooms are borne all summer and fall. Very hardy and drought tolerant. Good resistance to mildew. Recurrent bloomer.

BILL REID CANADIAN ARTISTS ROSE *Rosa 'Bill Reid'*

  90 cm / 36"  75 cm / 30"  July-September CPBR#4472

Very prolific bloomer for a yellow rose. Holds colour very well even in direct summer sun. This repeat bloomer is easy to care for with its built-in disease resistance. Contrasts nicely with today's darker foliage plants.

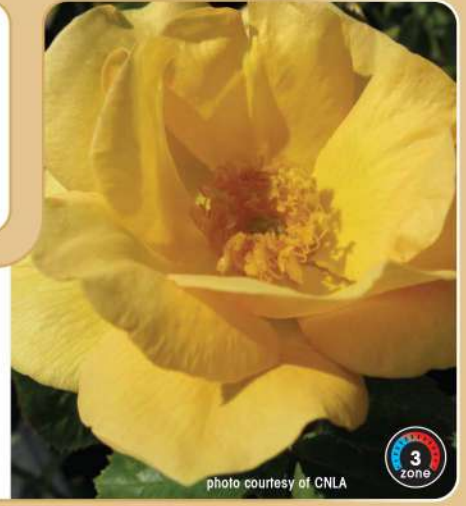
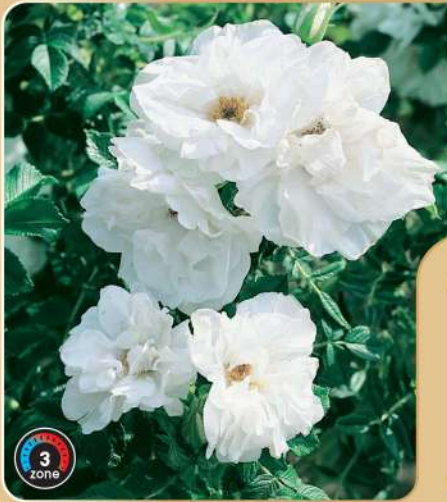

**BLANC DOUBLE DE COUBERT ROSE**
Rosa 'Blanc Double de Coubert'

  1.25 m / 4'  1 m / 3'  June-September

Deeply veined foliage complements the bluish buds that open to double, white blooms. Profuse bloomer summer to fall. Yellow fall foliage. Recurrent bloomer.

CAMPFIRE® CANADIAN ARTISTS ROSE *Rosa 'Campfire'®*


  75 cm / 30"  115 cm / 46"  July-September CPBR#4471

Named after a painting by Tom Thomson, this continuous bloomer has set the standard for hardy roses. The blooms are a smouldering blend of yellows, pinks and reds that continue to change with the season.

**CANADA BLOOMS ROSE** *Rosa 'Canada Blooms'*







  1.25-1.5 m / 4-5'  1-1.25 m / 3-4'  July-September




Large red flowers (42-52 petals) are produced throughout the summer and fall. Foliage is resistant to black spot and powdery mildew. A rose to celebrate Canada's 150th birthday in 2017.

**CHAMPLAIN ROSE** *Rosa 'Champlain'*

Masses of double, dark red blooms are produced from summer through fall. Very good field resistance to powdery mildew and black spot.

CHINOOK SUNRISE™ ROSE *Rosa 'Chinook Sunrise'™*

  1.25-1.5 m / 4-5'  1.25-2 m / 4-6'

This incredible rose blooms in a flush with a riot of exotic coral colours. 49th Parallel Collection.

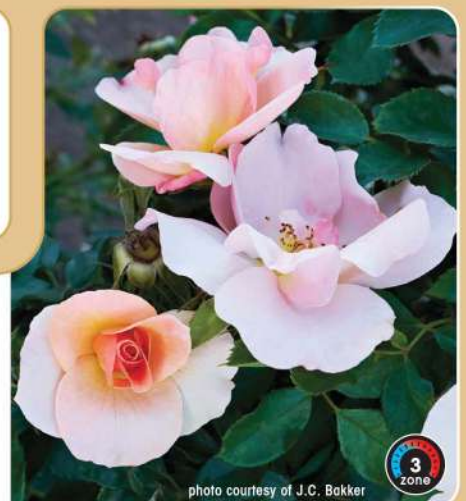
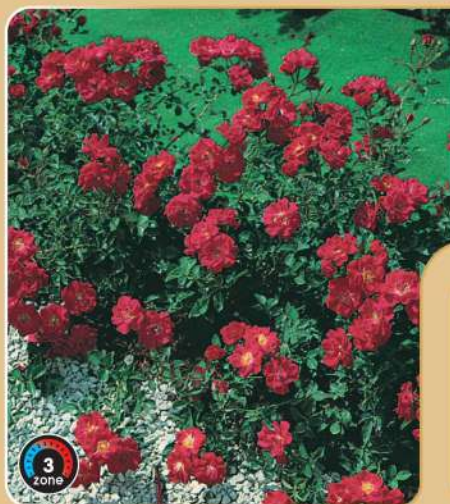




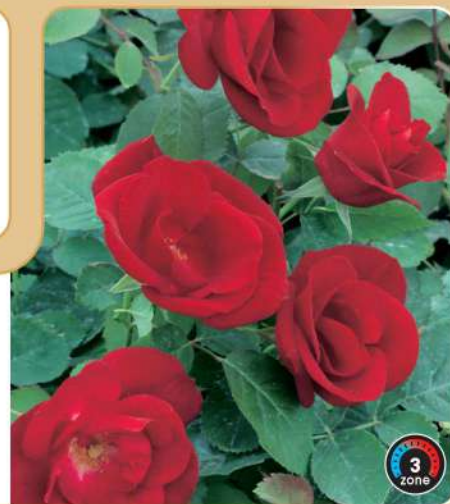

  1.25 m / 4'  1 m / 3'  July-September





Shrub rose with its double, crimson blooms has become an old time favorite of many gardens. Recurrent bloomer.

**EMILY CARR CANADIAN ARTISTS ROSE** *Rosa 'Emily Carr'*

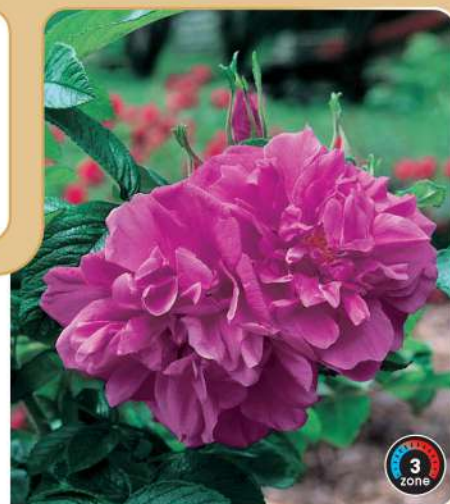

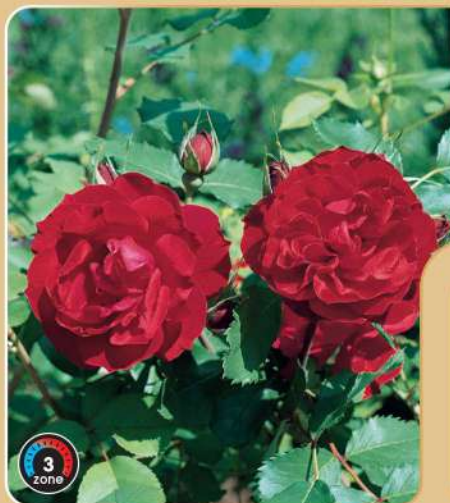

Resembles a lush display of pink bougainvilleas in full bloom from afar with its multiple clusters of vivid pink roses and vertical growth habit. Very drought tolerant once established.

**HANSA ROSE** *Rosa 'Hansa'*

An excellent hedge rose that produces double, reddish-purple flowers. Recurrent bloomer with brilliant orange fall foliage. Still one of the top choices for northern gardeners.

**HOPE FOR HUMANITY ROSE** *Rosa 'Hope for Humanity'*

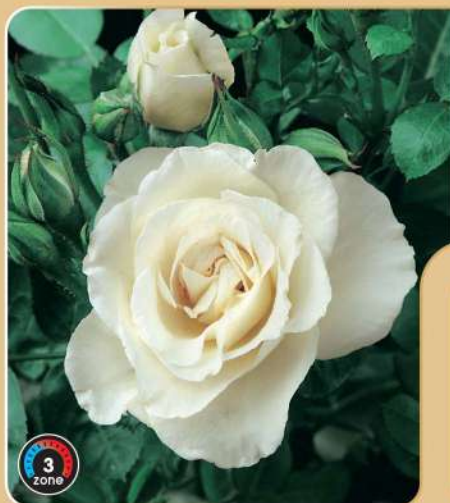

A low growing everbloomer with double, blood-red flowers. It will bloom approximately 12 to 14 weeks annually.

**JOHN CABOT ROSE** *Rosa 'John Cabot'*

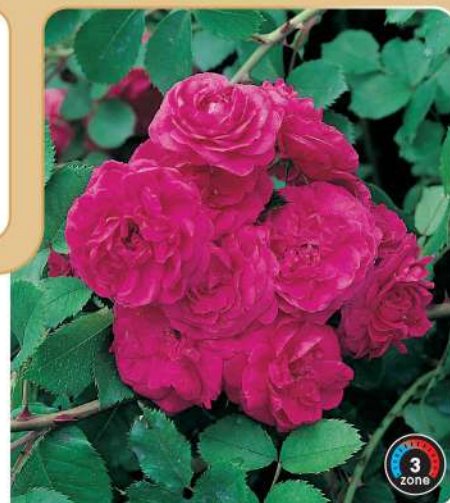

This climbing rose produces double, dark pink blooms on arching stems. Flowers are produced heavily throughout June and July with recurrent blooming until September.

**JP CONNELL ROSE** *Rosa 'JP Connell'*

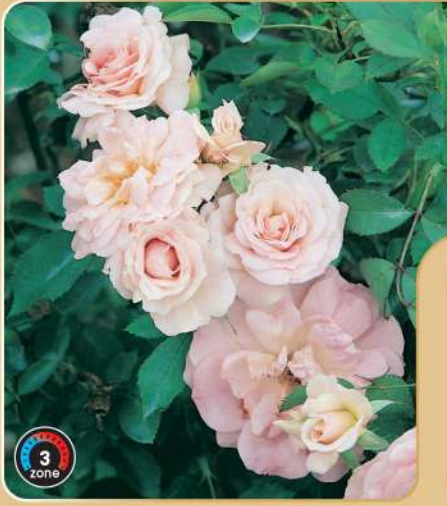

The first yellow rose from the Ottawa breeding program. A vigorous grower with deep yellow buds that open to a double, soft yellow blooms. Highly resistant to mildew and disease.

**MORDEN AMORETTE ROSE** *Rosa 'Morden Amorette'*

Very compact form compared to other shrub roses. Everblooming rose with semi-double, red blooms and distinctive petals that curl inward covering the center of the flower.

**MORDEN BLUSH ROSE** *Rosa 'Morden Blush'*

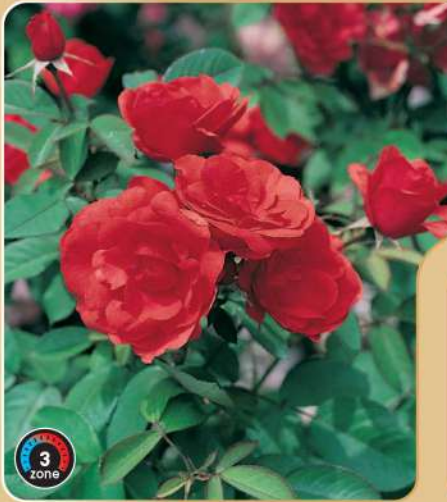

Double, light pink flowers. This everblooming rose changes colour with temperature. Pink in cool and ivory-white in hot weather.

**MORDEN CENTENNIAL ROSE** *Rosa 'Morden Centennial'*

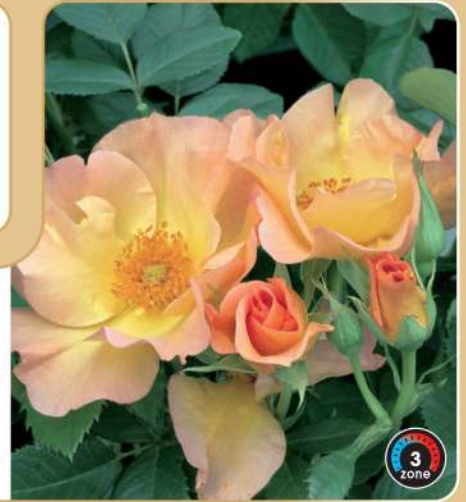

This recurrent shrub rose has double, medium pink blooms that appear on old or new wood and has good resistance to black spot.

**MORDEN FIREGLOW ROSE** *Rosa 'Morden Fireglow'*

Semi-double flowers in small clusters throughout the season of orange/red blend make this a plant in high demand. Recurrent bloomer.

**MORDEN SUNRISE ROSE** *Rosa 'Morden Sunrise'*

 \updownarrow 1 m / 3' \leftrightarrow 1 m / 3'  June-September COFF, USPP#13969



The creamy-orange buds open to fragrant blooms of yellow with pink blush fading to an attractive light orange. An everblooming shrub rose.

**NEVER ALONE™ ROSE** *Rosa 'Never Alone™'*

 \updownarrow 75 cm / 30" \leftrightarrow 75 cm / 30"  July-September


A continuous bloomer with fully double deep red blooms with a pale pink/white center that rest atop dark, clean glossy foliage. Ideal for patio pots or front borders. Royalties go to the 'Never Alone Foundation' to assist families and individuals that have been affected by cancer.

**OSCAR PETERSON CANADIAN ARTISTS ROSE**
Rosa 'Oscar Peterson'

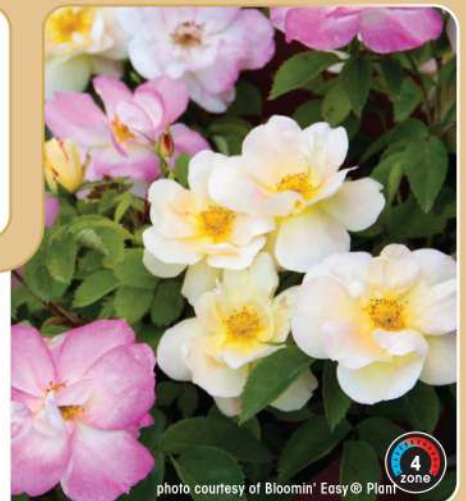

Oscar Peterson Rose is named after the Canadian born jazz pianist and composer. The semi-double flowers start out in a shade of soft yellow-cream, especially in cooler weather, then turn to a bright white with contrasting golden-yellow stamens. It grows upright to slightly spreading, making it a good specimen plant or an ideal hedging rose. This is among the hardiest roses that have appeared in the Canadian Artist Series.

**PRAIRIE JOY ROSE** *Rosa 'Prairie Joy'*

 \updownarrow 1.25 m / 4' \leftrightarrow 1.25 m / 4'  June-September

Double, pink blooms rest atop glossy dark green foliage. A Parkland series introduction from 1990. Recurrent bloomer.

**PEACH LEMONADE® ROSE** *Rosa 'Radpastel'*

 \updownarrow 1 m / 3' \leftrightarrow 1 m / 3'  Early summer to fall
CPBR#5392, USPP#26675

Multi coloured rose, starts out as lemon-yellow and fades to blush-pink. Dark green glossy foliage.

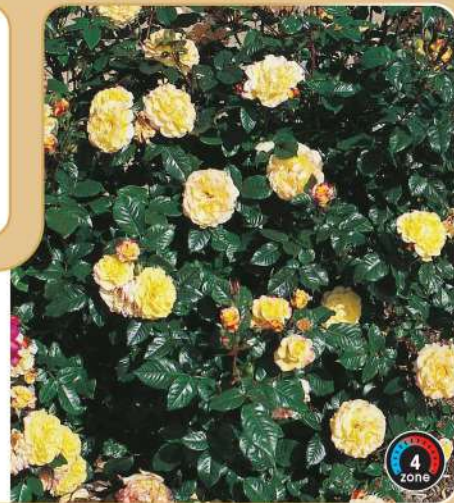

PURPLE PAVEMENT ROSE *Rosa 'Rotesmeer'*

  1 m / 3'  1.25 m / 4'  June-September

This recurrent bloomer produces semi-double, purple blooms similar to Hansa. Foliage is highly disease resistant and is attractive all season.



RUGELDA PAVEMENT ROSE *Rosa 'Rugelda Pavement'*

  1-1.5 m / 3-5'  1-1.25 m / 3-4'  Spring, summer, fall

Yellow, fully double flowers, slightly tinged with pink and orange-red buds. Continuous flowering, and salt tolerant. Do not prune back in fall.







SNOW PAVEMENT ROSE *Rosa 'Schneekoppe'*

  1 m / 3'  1 m / 3'  June-September

Very fragrant little rose that makes a great groundcover or low hedge. Flower buds are red opening to semi-double, white flowers. A non-recurrent bloomer.



THÉRÈSE BUGNET ROSE *Rosa 'Thérèse Bugnet'*

  2 m / 6'  1 m / 3'  June-September

Attractive foliage turns yellow-orange with reddish-brown stems in fall. Large, double, pink flowers. Recurrent bloomer.



WINNIPEG PARKS ROSE *Rosa 'Winnipeg Parks'*

  75 cm / 30"  75 cm / 30"  June-September
COPF, USPP#9122

Deep pink blooms are produced in clusters on this compact, everblooming shrub rose with attractive glossy foliage.



PRICKLY ROSE *Rosa acicularis*

  1.5 m / 5'  1.5 m / 5'  June-July

A non-recurrent shrub rose with single, pink flowers.




RED LEAF ROSE *Rosa rubrifolia*

  1.5 m / 5'  1.25 m / 4'  June-July

Masses of single, pink flowers with white centers. Will add to any landscape. One of the most drought tolerant varieties for the Prairies. A non-recurrent bloomer.



WOODS ROSE *Rosa woodsii*

  1.5 m / 5'  1.5 m / 5'  June-August

This non-recurrent shrub has single, pink flowers followed by many orange-red hips.
